RWCC and the ENVIRONMENT

Clearing of non-native vegetation and replanting of local native species along the boundaries of Riverina Water County Council including the Murrumbidgee River and Marshalls Creek is currently funded by Riverina Water County Council. This means all willows, rabinia, poplars etc have been removed/killed and replaced with gums, acacia, grevillea for example. Work began in 2001 with the support of WWCC, Greening Australia, local schools, LandCare and The River Precinct Group throughout the project. The aim of the project is to reduce erosion, increase habitats corridors and native fauna food supplies, improve the riverside appearance and allow native species to grow freely.
