The CEO and Director Engineering explained the updated modelling was being done as the proposed developments from constituent councils developments were not available at the time the original modelling was completed.

Are there any informal channels that should be created between member councils and Riverina Water to ensure Riverina Water is aware of new residential, commercial and industrial development? The Chair and CEO advised that we are not a "notifiable authority" and that through regular meetings between themselves and the constituent councils, we are able to learn of any significant developments, Riverina Water is relying on Planning Managers advising Riverina Water staff of any major developments.
